For now, in a week;

- we reach out to 6 institutions,
- Facilitate 11 sessions,
- Work with 83 young people,
- Collaborate with 10 instructors

Together with our partners of Project TEN, we facilitated a teacher seminar at People Concern Children Project (PCCP) in Kikubamutwe slum of Kabalagala, Kampala. The seminar was aimed at supporting the teachers' creative development, exposing them to new and effective ways of supporting young people to learn, making learning games from disposable materials.

We taught dance sessions at **Ecole Française Internationale de Kampala's** Olympic and Paralympic week, less than 500 days before the start of the Paris 2024 Olympic Games. Throughout the week, students from all classes were able to practice sports: Monday basketball, Tuesday dance and Wednesday skating. Thursday was dedicated to Paralympics, with sitting volleyball and blind football.



We taught breakdance workshops, facilitated creative movement activities and performed at the annual KISU art jam. We designed a walk workshop area where people came in, learned something and walked out, and later performed with us on stage.

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
